

## How to Care For Your New Paint Job

### First 30 Days

- Do not use a commercial car wash unless it is a touch less car wash. Stiff brushes can damage the surface. It is best to wash your vehicle by hand with car wash soap. Never use dish washing detergent because it is harsh and can scratch the paint.
- Never dry wipe your vehicle. It can scratch the finish. Use clean water to wash and rinse
- Keep your vehicle parked in the shade whenever possible.
- Try to avoid gravel roads. Chipping the finish is easily done during the first 30 days.
- Bird droppings need to be washed off immediately. The acid content quickly erodes paint, especially a freshly painted surface.
- Do not park under trees that drop sap.
- If you accidentally spill gasoline, oil, antifreeze, transmission fluid or windshield solvent, immediately rinse off with water. Do not wipe.

### First 90 Days

Do not wax or polish your vehicle. This allows time for your paint to completely harden. Never use wax or polish containing silicone.
